

## 25 years international cartosemiotic seminars (1991-2016)

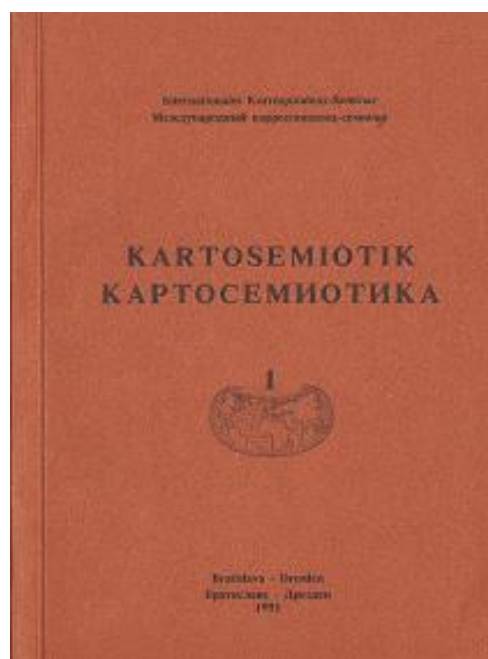
Schlichtmann Hansgeorg (Canada) and Wolodtschenko Alexander (Germany)



This poster informs about a set of international correspondence seminars in cartosemiotics, initiated in 1991. Their first proceedings were published (in German and Russian) in the discussion paper series "Kartosemiotik" / "Kartosemiotika", edited by J. Pravda and A. Wolodtschenko. Between 1991 and 1995, six issues have appeared.



The tradition of "Kartosemiotik" / "Kartosemiotika" was continued by a new series entitled "Diskussionsbeiträge zur Kartosemiotik und zur Theorie der Kartographie" (Discussion papers on cartosemiotics and on the theory of cartography), edited by A. Wolodtschenko and H. Schlichtmann. It contains contributions in German, Russian, and English. 19 issues have been published from 1998 till 2016; a 20th issue, an anniversary one, is planned for 2017.
